#### THE FIRST ORDINANCES

#### **PREAMBLE**

In furtherance of the objectives of the K. K. University established under Bihar Private University Act, 2013, [Bihar Act 20, 2013]the Board of Governors adopts the Statutes made thereunderthe First Ordinances vide section 32 of the Act to provide for the efficient, transparent and accountable governance and management of the University and any of the matters listed as under

#### PRELIMINARIES —

- (1) These ordinances may be called **K. K. University Ordinances**, 2017
- (2) They shall come into force on such date as the Governing Body may notify in the following domains.

#### (a) Admission of students—

In compliance with the norms set forth by the regulatory bodies like UGC, AICTE, NCTE, MCI, NCI, PCI and such agency/agencies established by the Central/State Government (Bihar) for regulation of education, the University will follow the following general criteria for selecting students for admission in various courses run by it.

\*Qualifying examination: Qualifying examination means an examination the passing of which makes a student eligible for admission to a particular year in a course of study leading to a Bachelor's or Post-Graduate Degree or Diploma conferrable by this University

#### (b) Courses of study for the Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates—

The multi-domain University would undertake course in the field of Arts, Science, Commerce, Management, Technology/Engineering, Education, Library Science, Journalism & Mass Communication, Law, Allied Health Science, Paramedical, Medical, Vocational, Certificate courses, Agricultural Science & Engineering, Veterinary and Dental Sciences, Fashion Technology and other similar domains of learning and instructions leading to awarding of certificates, diplomas and degrees in compliance with the norms set forth by the regulatory bodies.

In addition to traditional courses, University would also undertake courses like Production Engineering, Mining Engineering, Tourism management, Horticulture, Social Forestry, Agro-Forestry, Aeronautical Science and Technology, Non-Conventional Energy Resource Development such as Solar/Biogas 'Dual degree' and integrated Programs and integrated courses.

The minimum qualification for admission in the different academic Programs would comply with the norms prescribed by the regulatory bodies and the State Government by giving special emphasis on the Reservation Policies of the State Government for various categories of the students; particularly SC, ST, OBC, Minority, Physically challenged persons and women.

# (c) Award of Degrees, Diplomas, Certificates, Academic distinctions with the prescribed qualifications and the means to be taken relating to granting and obtaining the same.—

For award of Degrees, Diplomas, Certificates, Academic distinctions, the Board of Management of University shall empower appropriate authorities in conformity with the statutes for notification of the month and time of convocation through an advertisement in news papers and the 'Bulletin of the University'.

The conferment of all such Degrees /Diplomas/ Certificates shall have a procedural recommendation after successful completion of the examination requirements of the course/curricula from the hierarchical ends of the University starting from the Department to Academic Council, Registrar etc. and culminating in the order of the Vice-Chancellor.

On all such occasions, the guidelines of the regulatory bodies and the State Government shall be followed by the University strictly.

#### (d) Conditions for award of Fellowships, Scholarships, Stipends, Medals and Prizes

For award of Fellowships and Scholarships, the University shall invite applications through an advertisement in news papers for the awards to be made, in the month and time to be fixed by the Board of Management.

All awards of Fellowships, Research Scholarships and other Scholarships shall be made on the recommendation of the Academic Council by the Board of Management.

All sorts of stipends, medals, and prizes shall also be made, on the recommendation of the Academic councilby the Board of Management.

#### (e) Conduct of examinations

All arrangements for the conduct of examinations to be held by the University shall be made by the Controller of Examinations in compliance with the directions of the Board of Management. The Controller of Examinations shall prepare and publish a detailed program for the conduct of examinations and the last dates by which the examinees shall submit the application and the fees for taking examinations.

The Board of Management, in consultation with the Vice Chancellor, would appoint an Assistant Controller of Examinations together with Examination Supervisors and Observers.

The term of the office and the manner of appointment shall be decided by the Board of Management.

Duties of the Examining Bodies:— Integrity and good governance shall be the pivotal aspects of the examining bodies.

Duties of the Examiners:—The integrity of teaching learning processes shall be dealt with high esteem.

Duties of the Moderators:—Confidentiality of the compiled papers with a disaster prevention measure shall be the prime objective.

#### (f) Conditions of the residential students of the University

Compliance with Board of Management prescribed rules and regulations together with the undertaking for 'Anti-ragging' and protection of modesty of all girl students as per new circular of AICTE [F. No. 1-PC/AICTE/GP/2016 Date 08-07-2016] shall be one of the criteria for residence.

## (g) Special body for improving academic life of the University-its creation and composition

Civic, academic, cultural and philanthropic bodies shall function for improving the academic life of the University under the aegis of the Board of Management.

# (h) Manner of co-operation, collaboration with other Universities and Institutions of higher education

Collaboration, MOU with other Universities, Research Organizations, Industries the world over, shall be the prime efforts of the Academic Council functioningwith the approval of the Board of Management.
